



Find 7 things that are NOT dock safe




Never go to the dock alone


Uh-oh, no running!




Carrying too much stuff or being distracted can cause you to fall in the water



Make sure your life jacket fits properly






A whistle on a string may be just the thing to get the help you need. Keep one tied to your life jacket.

You could fall in and hurt yourself.











The dock is not a place to play alone
